Boys and Girls Basketball Tournament

Grades 4, 5 & 6 Girls - and - Grades 4, 5, & 6 Boys

- **Teams May provide a volunteer to serve at the scorer's table for each game.**
- Teams may consist of players from another grade; however the team will compete against the highest grade represented on the team.
- It is preferred that all team members are from the same School District.
- Teams must have numbered uniforms or shirts.
- A team roster must be submitted and only these members are eligible to play. A player can only be entered on one team.
- **Please bring your own basketballs for warm ups. Basketball will not be provided by Gwinn.**
- Teams shall be present at least one-half hour before their scheduled game with their line-up. Games may start up the 15 minutes early.
- Games will consist of two 16 minute halves with a running clock. Clock stops under two minutes of game and for free throws. Two time outs per half. There will be a 5 minute warm-up period and a 5 minute intermission. Warm-up and intermission may vary to keep the tournament on schedule.
- Sudden death overtime will be played, if necessary. Each team will be allowed one additional time-out.
- **The Championship games will not be double elimination.**
- Pressing will be allowed in 4th, 5th, and 6th grades for the last two minutes of the game. No team will be allowed to press if up by 15 or more points.
- The 4th grade teams will shoot a 13 foot free throw and can jump over the line after releasing the ball.
- All rules not covered above will be the same as those used by the MHSAA.
- Team expenses and liabilities for player's injuries cannot be assumed by the GASB or Gwinn School District.
- Any decision of the tournament director, referees, or committee in charge is final, and without appeal in case of disputes.
- Destruction of property by a member or members of a team shall disqualify that team and reimbursement of costs will be required.
- Any age bracket may be cancelled due to lack of response. Number of teams in each bracket will determine the type of play (i.e. pool or bracket play). Tournament Director(s) will not allow teams to switch playing times.
- **Spectators shall be respectful of the player, coaches, and officials or risk removal from premises.**
